Physical maps:

Use:

- navy blue for seas & oceans
- light blue for rivers & lakes
- brown for range of mountains
- a black triangle for peaks
- a red point for capes
- light green for plains.
- yellow for deserts
- light brown for tablelands
- orange for peninsulas
